

Thai Wedding & Blessing Grand Ceremony

This is the option of having a Buddhist wedding ceremony combined with elements of a traditional Thai wedding blessing. According to Thai tradition, the ceremony is usually held at one's home or the local temple. It starts with a festive parade to the bride's home, where it continues on to the ceremonial area. Monks then preside over a series of blessings in which the family and friends of the wedding couple may join.

Thai Wedding: Classic Ceremony Arrangement

Location	Right side of the hotel's beach (or our Spa Sala in case of rain)
Hae Khaan Maak	Traditional wedding parade with dancers and long drums, starting from the hotel lobby and ending at the ceremonial area.
Merit-Making Ceremony	The bride and groom light a candle and 3 incense sticks together one for Lord Buddha, one for the teachings of Buddha and one for monks. The monks start the ceremony, which consists of prayers and chanting. After each prayer the couple bows one time to pay respect to Lord Buddha and the Buddhist teachings. A length of twine is then passed from the Buddha statue through the monks hands and over the shoulders of the couple. This signifies the blessing of Buddha to the couple. Wedding couple then offer gifts to the monks called Sangkataan. The ceremony lasts around 30 minutes.
The Rings	We will prepare a beautifully decorated tray to hold the rings
Pook Mue	A short ceremony which involves monks and family members blessing the wedding couple by tying cotton string around their wrists.
Rod Nam Sang	The last ceremony where friends and family pour holy water that has been blessed by the monks over the hands of the wedding couple.
Music Decoration	Traditional Thai music and long drums Simple and elegant with flowers and fabrics in tons of white and natural green

- Traditional hand garlands for the wedding couple upon arrival to the resort
- Hairdresser & Make up for the bride
- Welcome drinks and cold towels upon arrival at the ceremonial area
- Ceremony area decoration designed by the hotel according to flower availability

Conditions:
